

2021 Cover Arizona Enrollment Scenarios

Maria and Daniel are married and have a set of twins. Daniel is a US Citizen; Maria has Legal Permanent Residency that began 01/01/2018. Their Children: Vanessa and Victoria are 2 years old and are US citizens. One month ago, they just moved to Tucson, AZ from San Antonio, Texas and need health insurance. Maria receives \$2,000 a month from Workers Comp and Daniel receives a gross monthly income of \$2,298 from employment.

Pablo and Lisa are married and have a 21-year-old daughter, Diana, that lives with them. Pablo has been a Lawful Permanent Resident for 7 years and he is self-employed, Lisa does not have income and is a US citizen. Pablo makes \$25,500 a year after business expenses. Pablo and Lisa file taxes together and do not claim dependents. Diana files her own taxes as single. Diana works at a nail salon and makes \$3,500 gross a month.

Gary is divorced and has a 3-year-old son, Robert. Robert lives with Gary 50 percent of the time. Gary does not claim Robert on his taxes, his mom Mary does. Robert has health insurance coverage provided by his mom through her employer. Gary is seeking enrollment assistance because he has diabetes and needs medical care. Gary has investment dividends income of \$500/month and employment income of \$1,300/month.

Lydia is a lawfully present immigrant with Employment Authorization (Not DACA). She is a 22-year-old student and works part-time making \$1,000 a month. She is seeking enrollment assistance to see what she would be eligible for although she feels she will not be able to afford coverage because of her low income.

Henry and Briana are married, and both are 67 years old and they have Medicare. They each get Social Security Retirement income of \$1,000/Month and have never applied for any Medicaid program. They recently adopted three of their grandchildren, Amy (5 years old), Reyna (7 Years Old), and Mathew (9 Years old) and their main concern is obtaining health care coverage for the children.
